There is an obvious restlessness in the church family to be physically together again. This is as it should be. We have lived all our lives in freedom with the independence to move about and meet freely, unlike some other countries.

It is natural, being restricted as we are, to push back. As you know, some churches in Oregon have challenged the Governor's right to restrict churches as she has. They won only to have that court decision over-ruled by a higher court.

Some folks gained heart when our President declared churches, synagogues, and mosques "essential", and called on Governors to allow churches to open up immediately. I appreciate someone sending me a link to the President's message which I listened to carefully a number of times. It certainly resonates with many frustrated Christians.

The Seventh-day Adventist churches in this district are part of a much larger church family called the Oregon Conference. We will work in harmony with the rest of the Church in Oregon to open our church buildings ASAP under Oregon Conference guidelines.

CHILOQUIN members will be notified when a plan is in place to begin opening up the church building.

BONANZA church building is open for Wednesday night prayer meeting at 6:30 p.m., Women's Ministries prayer group Monday mornings at 10:30 and other groups of less than 25 under Conference guidelines.

KLAMATH FALLS Fellowship Hall is open to groups of less than 25 people when scheduled through the church office beginning with Wednesday Night Worship at 6:30 p.m. The committee designated by the Church Board to facilitate opening up our facilities has spent hours planning and working to make this possible. Opening up the church building under the guidelines we have is not logistically practical under phase #1.

Thank you for being like Paul, Daniel, and many martyrs and saints who, over the years, have honored government orders in everything that didn't violate God's word. "Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus" Rev. 14:12

Greetings from your Church School!


