

### Missing a Limb?

“Again and again I have been instructed that the medical missionary work is to bear the same relation to the work of the third angel’s message that the arm and hand bear to the body. Under the direction of the divine Head they are to work unitedly in preparing the way for the coming of Christ. The right arm of the body of truth is to be constantly active, constantly at work, and God will strengthen it.” (CH 223) This health work is not to take the place of the third angel’s message, but to support it and work right alongside of it.

Carob Avocado Pudding  
 2 ripe avocados, peeled and seeded  
 1/4 c carob powder  
 1/4 c honey, agave or maple syrup  
 1/2 c almond milk (or any other plant-based milk)  
 1 tsp vanilla extract  
 1/2 tsp mint extract, optional

Place all ingredients in a blender and blend until smooth. Top with nuts, fruit, whipped topping, etc.


